

Noble Houses of the Common Folk

Note that these houses are some of the named families of the humans - for other races, see their individual Racial Packs.

Major (PLOT APPROVAL ONLY):

Parsonage - This line is lost or so it seems - No PC may take this bloodline

Masterson - Current King. No PC may take this bloodline

Az'Caine - Current Arch Mage - No PC may take this bloodline

Valenta - Higher Noble - Tradesmiths. Branches are Korath (land owners), Fellcal (Cattle)

Haton - Ancient bloodline - Templars. Branches are Riene, Ting, Kosh, Sorvath

Khalen - Ancient bloodline - Mages. Branches are Zareski, Elfner, Doutes

Xerxes - Honoured bloodline - Emissary to the Dwarven Lands. Branches are Hector, Menne, Haklish

Artruros - Powerful family of Mages and Scholars. This line is kept pure through Magical means.

Minor:

Gerard - Former King Line of Vincent Gerard, including Markus and Alistair his sons. Considered cowards by some. Retain their Noble title as they have Merchant Fleets that deal with the Valdenhold Elves, and with the Elves of Faybridge as well.

Feystand - Elenor Gerard's line continues through the Line of Feystand - This line is currently disgraced for Eleanor's rebellion, which for many will never be forgiven. If there are branches to this line, there are no families willing to lay claim. Strong dislike bordering on hatred with Elves of any kind.

Aklilu - Merchant house. Close ties to the Faybridge Elves and the Hobblings of the Silken Alliance. There are approximately 8 branches to this house.

Wheatly - Major Land owners / farmers – Most farming land in Calandra is overseen by the Wheatly house. They ensure that quotas are met to feed the army and other noble families. Farmers that meet the quotas are then able to sell their wares to anyone else with a percentage going to the Wheatly house for “administration expenses”. They are directly overseen by the Korlath House. There are approximately 15 ties to this house through arranged marriages.

Oaren – Major Land owners / ranchers. As the Wheatlys above, the Oaren House are ranchers and livery specialists. They are charged with raising all livestock that feeds the nation. As with the Wheatlys, once a rancher meets their quota for the season, they can then sell their livestock (live or butchered) to the general populace. Only the Oaren House may raise the War Horses the Home Guard use for cavalry. They are strictly overseen by the Generals in Calanda to ensure these specially bred steed never make it into the hands of non-military people. The Oaren house answers directly to the Fellcal House. There are approximately 10 ties to this house through arranged marriages.

Vanmil – Major Land owners / miners – A major player of minerals in the region. They are closely watched by the Dwarves, Orcs and Ogres in the area. There are approximately 8 ties to this house through arranged marriages.

Kalistax- Major Land owners / foresters – They have an “uneasy” alliance with the Elves and Fey who do not appreciate their “careless” forestry practices. There are approximately 12 ties to this house through arranged marriages.

Corstar- Nobles by duty as magistrates, lawyers etc. Some rumours of ties to the Purple Dragon/Silver Rose. There are approximately 6 ties to this house through arranged marriages.

Ostrem – Cartwrights. This house is the only source of ships and tradesmen that can build the vessels. There are approximately 5 ties to this house through arranged marriages. Although Calandra does not have a massive navy, merchant ships are always in high demand.

Gyverin - Astrologers and Cartographers. There are only 4 ties to this house.
